Within our world-class facilities, we expect a positive learning culture, a safe, welcoming environment, wise use of technology, positive communication and a nurturing Christian community.

We strive to build a culture that values academic success, with students seeking to affirm and encourage each other as they recognise and celebrate specific areas of learning achievement and growth. We believe that giving students a sense of belonging and connection fosters their wellbeing and motivates them to engage with learning. Alongside our commitment to academic success, we are equipping students with the character and skills to prepare them for the challenges of life beyond school. Motivated by God's love, we are intentional about nurturing and growing young people who will make a positive impact on Australian society as its future leaders.

Our History

NBCS was established in Mona Vale in 1981, by a group of parents who attended the Northern Beaches Christian Centre church. Their vision was to build an exceptional Christian School in the Northern Beaches area and was made a reality through the sacrifice, dedication and generosity of many parents and friends.

Beginning with just 39 students, one teacher and a roster of parent volunteers, the school slowly grew in those early years. In 1984 a building program commenced on the current Echunga Road campus, formally opening in February 1986. The school has continued to evolve and grow over the years, growing to current numbers of over 1100 students. From simple buildings to stunningly designed learning spaces, the school has stayed true to its early vision of providing excellent education within a nurturing Christian community.

We are thankful for the courage and determination of those who have provided our school with such a strong foundation on which to continue building upon.

Pursuing and celebrating academic excellence

At the heart of every school is the pursuit of academic excellence. At NBCS we recognise that this will look different for every student, and our hope is that each individual learning journey will be shaped by curiosity and a love of discovery.

We encourage our students to go beyond the dissemination and digestion of facts, to make connections between what and how they are learning and who they are, as well as the impact they want to make on the world around them - both now and in the future.

Learning Enrichment and Support

We recognise and foster the individual interests and abilities of students, within a well-structured learning environment. As we seek to support and enrich learning opportunities, we are shaping confident, resilient students who seek ownership of their learning, ensuring they are prepared to thrive and adapt in the world outside of school. Working alongside our teachers, our Learning Enrichment team provides research-based interventions and collaborative programming to meet the diverse learning needs of our students, both supporting and enriching learning opportunities.

In Primary, our team includes specialist teachers and occupational therapists. They support our teachers in assessing and identifying the needs of our students, and work one-on-one or in groups with these students in extension or learning support classes.

The second part of our Mission statement, *Christianity in Action*, is no less important than our commitment to academic excellence. It provides a deep framework for our community, shaping our values and culture. NBCS is built upon trust in a God who graciously loves, rescues and redeems. Through evidence-informed programs, students develop their relational ability and resilience, as they pursue opportunities to serve the community.

NBCS is a school known and appreciated for our strong relational connections, pastoral care, personalised learning, low stress high results environment, and our foundation in the Christian faith that provides stability for our present and hope for the future. NBCS aims to create a school where students can achieve at their greatest potential, while keeping stress at bay. Working together as a community, we seek to provide the opportunities and resources to help our students thrive and develop the skills to achieve a healthy balance between study and rest - a pattern that will set them up to succeed beyond school.

Our caring, nurturing community is founded on Christian hope and the belief that every student has God-given potential and worth. We want to see our students not only succeed academically, but in all areas of life, so they can live intentional, fulfilling lives.

Our Wellbeing Team and Emotional Health Platform provide support to our students and their families as they navigate through difficult times. This Platform provides an easy way to seek help for themselves or others, and offers other helpful resources and tools.

It is important that each student feels safe, supported and has a sense of belonging. Our values of Gratitude, Courage, Respect, Compassion and Commitment help shape a functional, connected community where students can grow in resilience and self-knowledge, and persevere through challenging times.

Co-curricular

Extending opportunities and enriching lives

Whether it is creative and performing arts, music, debating and public speaking, outdoor adventure, service, sport, media, or technology, we seek to give our students the chance to discover and grow their God-given talents. These opportunities often lead to new interests, enabling our students to develop confidence as lifelong learners and participants.

Academic

A range of opportunities are on offer for students to extend critical thinking, analysis and application of theory and study to real world situations. Programs vary between Mock Trials, Model United Nations, philosophy and political thinking, with clubs emerging to cater for student interest and current global events. A complementary academic assistance schedule provides opportunities for students to obtain support from subject-specific teachers before and after school, as well as some lunchtimes.

Creative Arts

Creativity is encouraged through different techniques and mediums, ranging from drawing and painting to jewellery making. Workshops are proposed based on student interest and can include pottery, painting and mixed media projects. A number of activities are offered as recreational clubs at lunchtime, with others focusing more on the development of specific skills.

Global Opportunities

We offer an extensive range of Global Opportunities, providing enriching learning experiences for Secondary students, both nationally and internationally. Curriculum tours enhance learning related to specific subject areas, with service and leadership initiatives, cultural immersions, sport tours and language exchanges. There is a strong focus on encouraging students to earn and save to contribute to their experience.

Music

There are many avenues for students to explore and develop their musical talents with a great breadth of ensembles, along with private music tuition. The diverse program caters for different styles, so that students can pursue different genres such as classical, jazz and pop music.

Outdoor Education

Outdoor Education is an important part of Primary and Secondary. In Primary, camps are the main avenue for our students to experience Outdoor Education. In Secondary, our unique Student Opportunity Week provides students with the opportunity to choose from a vast range of programs, based on their passions or interests. Outdoor Education can also be pursued through The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award, offered at the Bronze, Silver and Gold levels, through progression or direct entry pathways.

Performing Arts

Students have the opportunity to participate in public speaking, debating, theatre sports and drama clubs. Dance ensembles across several genres are offered, providing students with the opportunity to develop and refine technique. The annual Secondary Musical is a highlight for many students.

Sport

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We aim to provide students with a comprehensive and balanced program of sporting activities. In doing so, we foster and develop students' character, social relationships and sportsmanship, embodying our Christian ethos. Our sports program gives students the opportunity to acquire and develop a range of skills, physical abilities and attitudes that help develop a sense of team and school spirit. This is a solid foundation for a life-long, active lifestyle. There is also the opportunity for particularly gifted students to develop expertise and discipline that will help them to pursue representative sporting commitments beyond school.

STEM

The STEM program evolves and develops with emerging technologies, providing opportunities in coding, robotics, design and engineering. Activities vary in the degree of skill and technology required, with opportunities for students to pursue State, National and International pathways for a range of competitions.



Shaping and engaging talented Christian staff

Exceptional staff make exceptional schools. Developing our teachers, and the staff who support them, is an ongoing priority. Effective teaching is shaped by the appointment and development of quality staff who share a commitment to learning and the Christian faith. By working together, we create and maintain a strong learning culture for all and improve learning outcomes for our students.

Exceptional teachers

We place great importance on fostering relationships with students and their support networks, so that we can better understand how each student learns and encourage their resilience and independence.

Our teachers are dedicated and passionate. They make it an absolute priority to establish and maintain a positive relationship with their students, knowing that they learn best from teachers they have a good relationship with. NBCS teachers walk alongside families to ensure our students are getting the care and support they need to stay connected and engaged. They are accessible to parents with many opportunities to provide and discuss your child's learning journey.

Infrastructure

Inspiring and invigorating learning

Our state-of-the-art campus reflects the important balance between form and function. It is shaped by the belief that learning spaces and technology must meet the needs of students and teachers, while inspiring new possibilities for learning. Our facilities exist to help bring our Mission and Vision to life.

Together, with our architectural partners WMK Architecture, we have a bold vision for our learning spaces. Both inside and outside spaces are dynamic and flexible to enhance learning. Many classrooms have dual functionality, with the capability to be opened up to allow multi-class learning and partitioned for more focused learning within year groups. Catering for a diverse variety of users at any one time, all learning spaces are powered by a robust campus-wide Wi-Fi, custom modular furniture, generous windows with natural light, floor-to-ceiling whiteboard walls, and large-screen displays.

The canteen, 'Grounded Cafe', is at the heart of a central covered outdoor space and is a vibrant meeting place for students, teachers, parents and visitors.

Underpinning the award-winning architectural design is our commitment to sustainability. Fundamental to the design is a sequence of multi-level pavilion buildings beneath a spectacular 3,000sqm intelligent 'living' structure, which generates energy through an 80 kw solar system, harvests rainwater, and cools the spaces below.

WMK has also designed for maximum use of natural light and ventilation. Windows and louvres in the building and canopy are automated to provide ventilation in direct response to climate conditions using a sophisticated Building Management System. This ensures we reduce our environmental footprint.
