Learning at Athena

Our approach is friendly and caring and works to develop a passion for learning in the students. To achieve this, we provide smaller classes with a higher teacher/student ratio and more personalised attention.

The school's educational focus is on nurturing the student's individual talents and encouraging an enquiring mind.

Students at Athena are introduced to a simple, practical method of study from their early school years. By the time they arrive in High School they are developing the skills to independently be able to use this method of study to investigate and research any topic of interest. Furthermore, this method of study results in the students truly understanding what they have learned, so they can put their knowledge to practical use in the workaday world.

Students at The Athena School are taught so that they can apply what they learn.

A common problem with students throughout the world is that they cannot *apply* the information they have studied when faced with practical situations.

Students at The Athena School learn to correlate one piece of information to a totally different piece of information taught later on. The information becomes their own, rather than being something they must endure so they can pass a test.

Furthermore, with our Quality Assurance department, we can assist any students who are having difficulty and give them one-on-one assistance to help them get back up to speed. Any students who don't get 100% on their tests are likewise assisted by Quality Assurance. Here the materials they haven't fully grasped are gone over, so that they fully understand the area before they carry on with their studies.

Through this approach we have found students enjoy what they study and find it easier to study as they carry on through school and into life. After all, that is where the child must actually use the data – in *life*.



Curriculum from Kindy to High School

Here at Athena, we make it our passion to get out into the world and where ever possible, to see what we are learning about first hand. This brings education to life.



Ethics and morals

Qualities such as personal integrity, responsibility and respect for self and others are necessary for a happy and worthwhile life, and therefore guidance towards these qualities is considered an important role of the school.

The non-religious moral precepts contained in Mr Hubbard's *The Way to Happiness* are used for this purpose. Included are:

- * 'Honour and help your parents'
- * 'Set a good example'
- * 'Be worthy of trust'
- * 'Respect the religious beliefs of others', and
- * 'Try to treat others as you would want them to treat you'.

While the school is not run on authoritarian lines, positive control is used and self-discipline is fostered through the use of the precepts in *The Way to Happiness*. The school has a zero tolerance on bullying.

At Athena we strive for friendliness and approachability between parents and staff to help resolve any concerns relating to the child's progress at school.

Community Work

Being of service to his or her community plays a big part in the upbringing of a child in today's world.

Many of Athena's students are Drug-Free Ambassadors and help in encouraging young people to lead drug-free lives.

Australian Residents Fee Schedule 2017

Application Fee

\$120 non-refundable application fee is required to process each new enrolment. This includes a personal assessment by our Quality Assurance Division.

Enrolment Fee

\$1,000 non-refundable enrolment fee is required upon enrolment of the first child in the Athena School. The enrolment fee is a one-off payment per family.

Fee Security Deposit

\$1,000 fee security deposit for the first child in the family and \$500 for each extra child in that family, payable upon confirmation of entry into the school at all levels. This is refundable at the request of the parent/guardian, net of any unpaid fees, only when the student leaves the school.

Tuition Fees per term (there are four terms in a school year)

Please note that it is expected that High School students will bring their own device to school.

Discounts

Sibling Discount: 20% discount will be given to the paying parent/guardian for the 2nd child, with 40% discount for the 3rd child. Each subsequent child will be free, if all are attending the school at the same time.

There is no discount on Materials/ Excursion Fees.

Terms of payment

All parents/guardians are asked to read the terms and conditions of payment carefully. Should there be any confusion on the subject, please contact the Bursar or Office Manager.

EITHER: Total term's fees (includes Materials/Excursion Fee) payable in advance before start of term (9.00am on the first day of term), which attracts a 5% discount on the Tuition Fees.

OR: Two payments per term, i.e. first payment prior to start of term and second payment halfway through the term.

Any requests for different payment arrangements need to be put in writing for approval by the Executive Council of the School. Late fees are handled as per the Fees in Arrears section below.

Terms and Conditions of enrolment

NON-ATTENDANCE

Fees are payable for the whole term of enrolment. No deduction may be made for non-attendance, for any reason.

WITHDRAWAL

Parents/guardians must give four weeks' written notice of withdrawal of a student or forfeit 4 weeks' fees in lieu.

FEES IN ARREARS

Fees in arrears will immediately incur a forfeit of all discounts. A charge of \$50 per month is attached to all fees overdue (charged on the 1st day of each month).
