To clarify details in the literature and on the website, enquiries by phone, fax, email or post are welcome; however, to adequately help you select the best option, a personal consultation involving the prospective student and a supporting person e.g. a parent, should be arranged as soon as possible.

There is no charge for the consultation and certainly no compulsion to enrol. Consultations are conducted throughout the year. The most popular time is the latter part of the year and the Christmas Vacation.

In circumstances where a personal consultation is not practical because of distance, an interview by telephone can be arranged. Although not ideal, it has proven to be helpful in the past.

Enrolment

Quotas and minimum enrolment numbers per subject exist for all Senior External subjects. Generally, enrolments can readily be accepted until classes formally commence in late January/early February each year. However, **to ensure a place in your preferred subjects, you are advised to submit your completed Enrolment Agreement as soon as the decision to enrol has been made.** Acceptance will take the order of receipt of completed Enrolment Agreements into account.

Since our courses commence **Wednesday 28th January 2015** and timetabling must be finalised well before then, it is helpful that your **enrolment be completed on or before Wednesday January 14th 2015.**

Late enrolments are always considered. Do ask. We do try to cater for individual needs.

Also, in some circumstances, the Queensland Curriculum and Assessment Authority (QCAA) must be advised and give **approval** for enrolments in Senior External subjects. Hubbard's School staff are able to assist you with this process. A response from QCAA will be given, usually within three weeks.

If you are currently completing Year 12, realistically you may prefer to wait until you receive your Senior Certificate. It is important to enrol as soon as practical. As an early applicant, you can enjoy the advantage of peace of mind about your academic progress in the immediate future. It is a requirement to have a consultation with the Principal before enrolment.


Enrolment requires completion of enrolment documents, payment of a \$100 non-refundable registration fee and proof of age. It is policy to sight originals or copies of your most recent academic report or Senior Certificate and any current court orders if applicable, before your enrolment is finalised. This helps to ensure you have selected the most appropriate option.

Enrolling after Year 12 or as an adult:

- ★ Almost stress-free.
- ★ 5 Sound Achievements guaranteed Rank 81. This can be maximised to 90 (\approx OP6).
- ★ 5 Very High Achievements = Rank 99 \approx OP1.
- ★ Study from one to four subjects – as appropriate for your situation.
- ★ Attend classes Monday to Friday as required from February to October.
- ★ May be completed over one or more years.
- ★ Daytime classes only.
