NEWINGTON COLLEGE'S THREE CAMPUSES



STANMORE 7–12

The Secondary campus is located in Stanmore, in Sydney's Inner West, just minutes from the CBD and Sydney University. Set on nine hectares of grounds, Newington is close to major transport links for all Sydney suburbs.

Newington boarders come from country and city, interstate and overseas. 1,150 day boys are drawn from all over the Sydney greater metropolitan area.

The Secondary campus comprises the Middle School (Years 7–9) and Senior School (Years 10–12) and has been structured to best cater for the learning, pastoral and developmental needs of boys at various stages of their maturity.

The College has outstanding facilities including excellent IT capacity, 'purpose built' music performance hall and practice rooms, a new state-of-the-art Technology area and a specialist Year 7 wing. The PE Centre has an indoor heated swimming pool, weights room and two gymnasiums and caters for basketball, volleyball, indoor football as well as a range of other sports.

All-weather surfaced tennis courts, turf pitches and synthetic practice pitches for cricket and the superb boatshed on the Parramatta River at Abbotsford provide outstanding resources for all Newington's sporting pursuits. Building has commenced on a new Library Resource Centre and Science facilities.

The playing fields at Stanmore cater for most outdoor games played during the summer and winter seasons.

Also located at Stanmore, Wyvern House Preparatory School has approximately 470 boys.

Wyvern House is a purpose built school that was designed with the educational needs of boys fully considered.

Classrooms are spacious, with plenty of room for class activities, dedicated storage bays for the boys' property and adjoining learning spaces. Specialists teach Music, Art, PE, French and provide learning support. There are also strong ICT programs.

Facilities include a Library/Resource Centre, a Computer Laboratory, specific labs and studios for Art and Music, a large rooftop covered area that provides a protected playground for the boys and a number of sizeable outside recreation areas, including a basketball/tennis court and undercover drive through pick up/drop off area.

Wyvern boys are also able to take advantage of the extensive grounds and facilities of the Secondary School, which is only a few minutes walk away.

LINDFIELD K–6

Newington's long-established Preparatory School at Lindfield caters for boys from Kindergarten to Year 6 in Sydney's North Shore and has an excellent reputation for nurturing boys throughout their primary years.

The Lindfield cohort is small, with only 160 boys. This allows our boys to develop their individual talents and build close relationships with their teachers that inspire confidence in learning. The parent body is closely connected to each facet of school life.

Set alongside beautiful bushland, the school has undergone extensive refurbishment with new facilities built. Newington is at the forefront of implementing effective and contemporary strategies with respect to the education of boys. The school is an International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme candidate. Strong links with the Secondary campus at Stanmore ensure the transition to Year 7 is smooth and well-supported.
