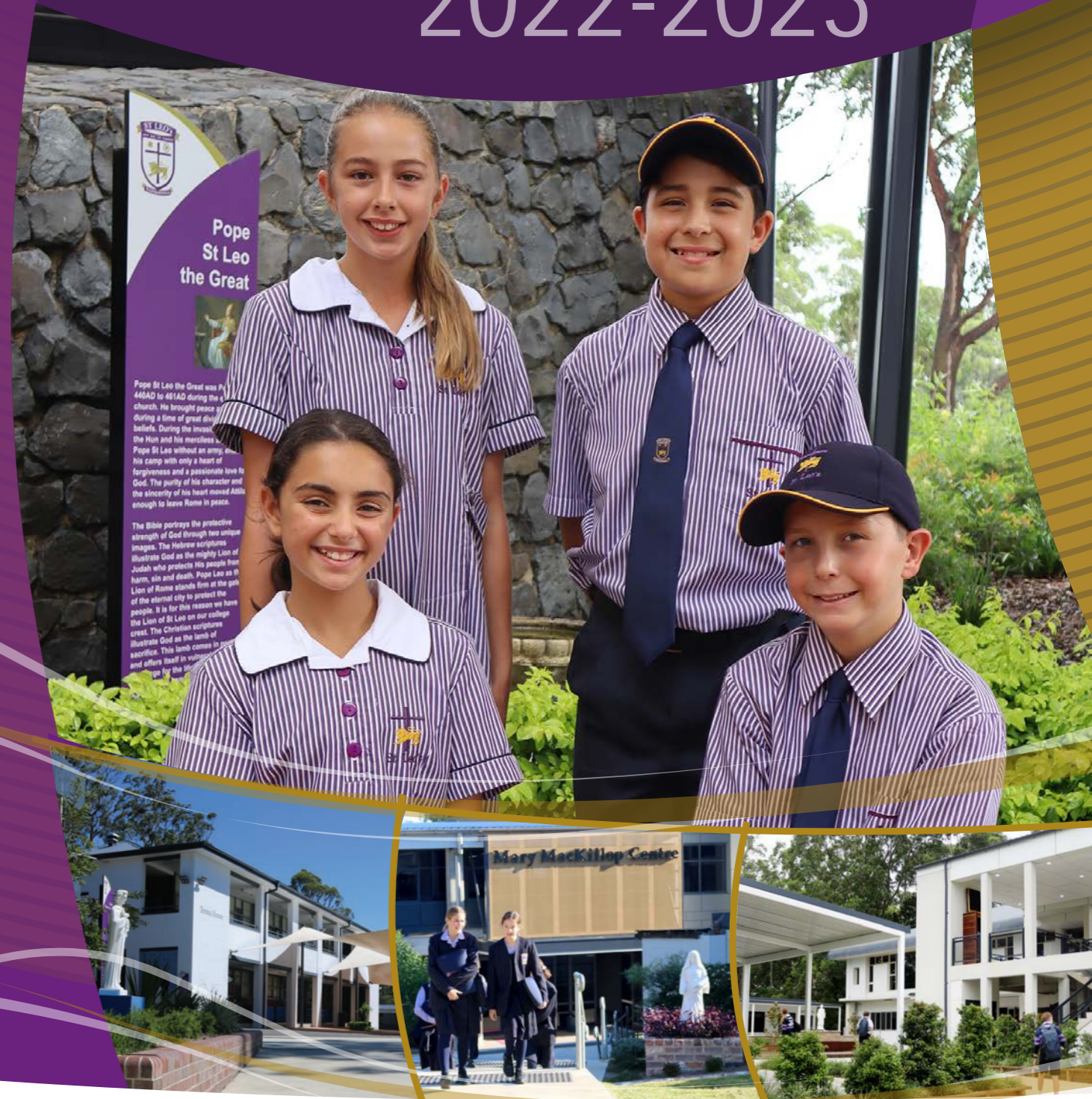

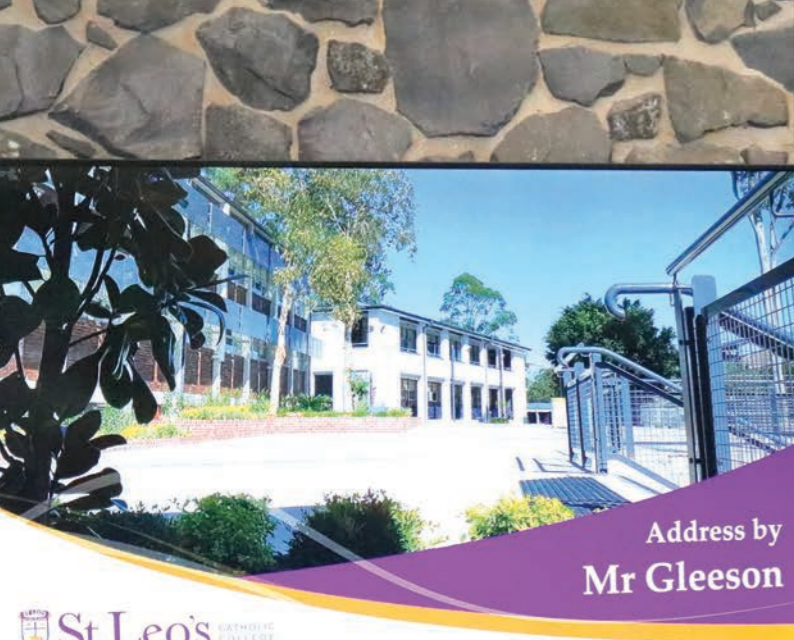

**Our newly upgraded campus is located on six hectares in the leafy suburb of Wahroonga and is the only co-educational Catholic secondary school on Sydney's Upper North Shore.**

- As a caring, inclusive community renowned for our pastoral care, we have a strong focus on knowing each student and growing their unique potential and passion.
- A distinct STEM and innovation focus, offering a range of programs to ensure our students have the skills they need for a globalised world.
- We pride ourselves on achieving consistently strong academic results, with students regularly appearing in the HSC High Achiever and All-rounder lists. Over 70 percent of students are offered a university place each year.
- We are consistently above the average student growth in NAPLAN - across both State and SSSG schools (Statistically Similar School Group).

## Pastoral Care and Wellbeing

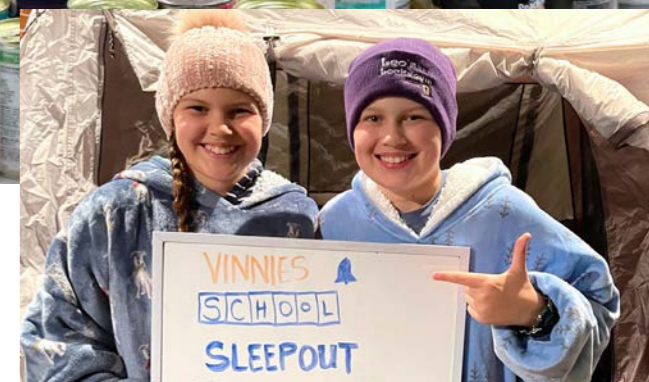

# Catholic Life and Mission

St Leo's is first and foremost a Catholic school, with the religious dimension of the College being a shared partnership between families, parish communities and the College.

Religion is an essential and comprehensive area of study for all students, prayer an important part of daily life, regular religious gatherings and celebrations not only embraced but enthusiastically led by students, and Christian leadership fostered through our Youth Ministry Program.

Students in Years 7-10 attend a Spirituality Day each year to help them develop their spiritual lives amidst their busy academic schedules, while the College provides a three-day retreat for both Year 11 and Year 12. A real sense of community exists at St Leo's and our newly refurbished Chapel is the spiritual heart, where a weekly Mass is also held which students have the option to attend.



## Our Faith in Action – Social Justice

There is a significant focus at St Leo's putting our faith into action and giving students agency and confidence to build a world that is positive, just and inclusive.

Our Youth Ministry staff empower students to put their faith into practice with a range of social justice opportunities. The College's Vinnies School Conference raised over \$30,000 in 2021 with activities including Project Compassion, the Vinnies Winter Sleepout and Christmas Appeal.

Students from Year 7-12 can express their passion to make a difference in our world through our Social Justice League and our Environmental Care Group. Outreach opportunities include Street Retreats in the city to learn about homelessness and visits to local nursing homes.



# Our College Facilities – Prepared for the Future

St Leo's is located on six hectares in the leafy Upper North Shore suburb of Wahroonga and has just completed an extensive \$30M campus and technology upgrade.

Our facilities include:

- the new state-of-the-art Mary MacKillop Centre for Creative and Performing Arts, Design, Technology and Hospitality, including:
  - dance theatre with retractable seating
  - separate drama studio
  - art gallery and visual art studios
  - specialty music, rehearsal rooms and individual instrumental tuition rooms
  - two commercial-grade kitchens
  - two TAS workshops for woodwork
  - several large meeting and gallery spaces
  - numerous purposeful and flexible learning spaces

- the Light of Christ Centre – a multipurpose complex for over 1500 people used for indoor sports, assemblies, musical productions and a range of College functions and events
- a newly refurbished Chapel
- two full-sized sports ovals
- two large, shaded outdoor recreational areas
- a well-equipped Aquinas Resource Centre including library and cafe
- newly refurbished canteen.

## Preparing Students for the Future – Technology, Innovation and More

We have a distinct STEM and innovation focus, offering a range of programs to ensure our students have the skills they need for a globalised world.

Technology is an integral part of daily learning, with individual student iPads or MacBooks and other learning technologies serving as important tools in developing critical thinking, creativity, collaboration and communication skills. Our experience has found that technology-enabled teaching and learning allows for more active engagement, it allows teaching to meet the student at their particular point of learning, and students are encouraged to advance their skills in a safe environment.

Our Learning Den is a custom-built online learning platform on which students can record and track their progress in a range of areas, giving them learning ownership and a digital portfolio to take with them to show employers when they leave.

Our innovative Pathways Program works with students and their families to navigate life beyond school, developing industry and higher education partnerships, and shaping new offerings and approaches to learning at St Leo's.

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) is a major focus at St Leo's. We have an interdisciplinary approach, where students apply STEM skills to make connections between school, community, work and the global enterprise. We work with a range of industry experts on real-world applications and challenge-based learning activities to also foster collaboration, teamwork and other essential skills while having fun.

We run a large number of STEM co-curricular and extracurricular activities for students of all levels. A few of the many current opportunities include:

**CAPA:** an extraordinary 20 co-curricular ensembles are offered to all our students, free of charge, from Girl's Rock to Accordion groups, Theatresports and Art Club to Drumline

**Sport:** A huge range of sports are offered as part of our weekly Sport for Life program, from self-defence to surfing. In addition, we have a tiered representative and high-performance program and a new partnership with Liverpool FC International Academy





# Beyond the Classroom – Creative and Performing Arts

**Creative and Performing Arts (CAPA) are an integral part of the curriculum at St Leo's.**

The College specialises in Music, Dance, Drama and Visual Arts for Years 7 -12.

Our \$14M state-of-the-art Mary MacKillop Centre highlights our commitment to the arts and includes a drama and dance theatre with fully retractable seating, art gallery and studios, along with dedicated orchestra, band and music rooms.

Our exceptional music program includes various band, ensemble and choir programs, and an annual musical or drama production. Additionally, the College offers an impressive 20 co-curricular CAPA Ensembles (free to

all St Leo's students) and our specialist Private Music Tuition Program.

Our annual Showcase is an impressive community event featuring outstanding student works across the spectrum of Creative and Performing Arts.

St Leo's students regularly win awards and Eisteddfods, and are frequently invited to exhibit at ARTEXPRESS and ENCORE.

We are very proud to have had three students offered places at NIDA for 2019 and a First in the State for HSC Drama for 2021.
