
On behalf of the College Board and the College Leadership Team we are delighted to present the College Strategic Plan for 2021-2024.





Values


Our College is impelled by the Parable of the Good Samaritan, guided by the Rule of St Benedict and inspired by the work of the Sisters of the Good Samaritan.
