We are proud to introduce one of the most exciting projects for Sydney Boys High and Sydney Girls High in recent years: The Governors Centre, an ambitious state-of-the-art educational facility which is in the advanced planning stage and will transform education. This project is driven by the belief in the need to support learning with facilities that reflect the talents of our students. The Centre is named in honour of two of the outstanding governors of our state, Professor Dame Marie Bashir and Sir Roden Cutler, both highly respected alumni of Sydney Girls High and Sydney Boys High.

The Governors Centre will have a greater capacity to enhance learning across the creative and performing arts, debating and public speaking, academic lectures and master classes. This facility will be an asset to both schools, not only offering a world class educational resource but will do much for our students' social interaction and cohesion.

There has already been a generous commitment by both school communities to the provision of quality resources for public education. Support from many people, financially and professionally, has allowed the project to advance to the stage of final design and a building start date in 2016. The building phase of the project is very close, but further support is still needed.




Like so many students of Sydney Girls High School, and Sydney Boys High School, a sense of gratitude for the exceptional years of scholarship and camaraderie never fades.
