Capturing the calm beauty of our campus, the snapshots of College life reflect the character of CHAC - collaborative, creative, ambitious and successful - with energy to grow.

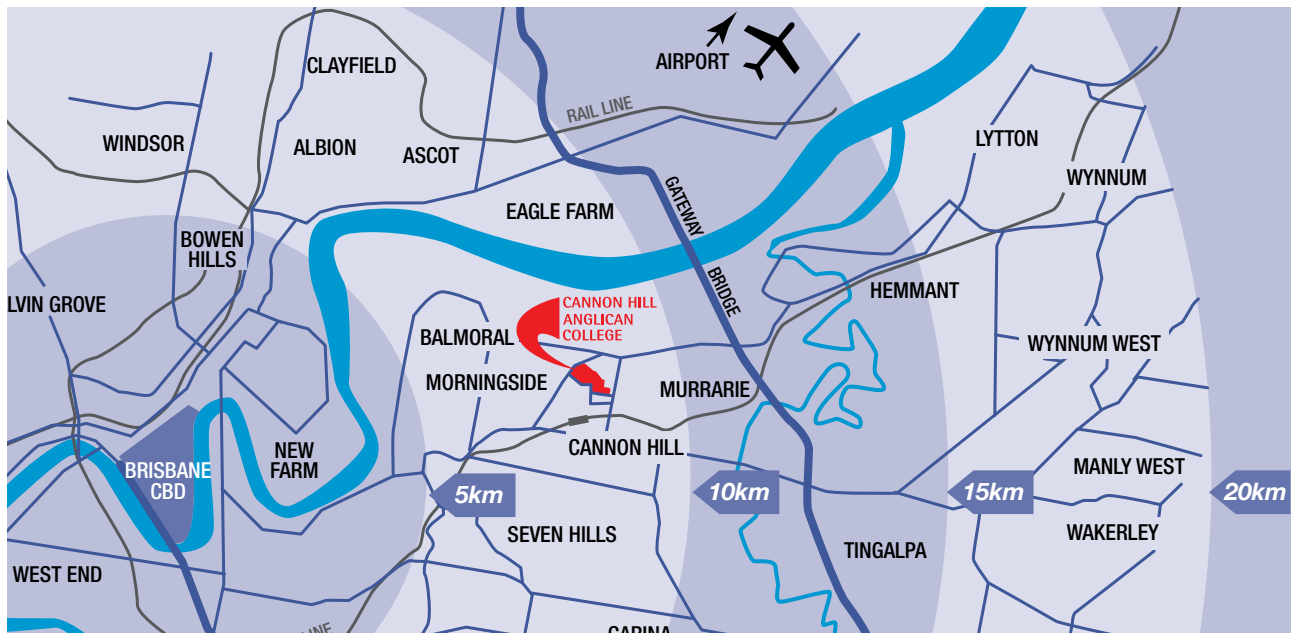

Just 7 kilometres and 15 minutes from the CBD, in a quiet suburban setting, the College is within 10 minutes easy walking distance from Cannon Hill Railway Station, is conveniently located on major public and dedicated school bus routes, and is well served by key road networks.

Access from the inner city and northern suburbs is via CityCat ferries, Story Bridge or Gateway Bridge - which also provides a link to Brisbane Airport in just 15 minutes.
