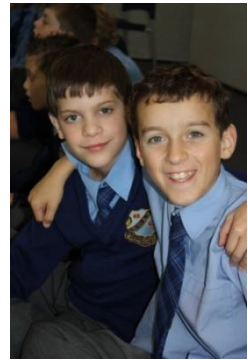

In recognition of being the foundational High School class, all students from the 2013 Year 8 class will become Foundation Members. A Foundation Members' Discount on tuition fees of 7% will apply in addition to family and early payment discounts, and these students will pay Year 8 fees through to Year 12.

A 2.5% discount is given to families who pay the entire **term's** fee by the second week of each term.

A 5% discount is given to families who pay the entire **year's** fee by the second week of the school year.

## 2012 REGISTRATION FEES

The school also charges a Registration Fee to cover the cost of consumable classroom resources. You will still be responsible for purchasing a small list of personal items for your child. This list will be supplied by your child's teacher on Registration Day.

The following annual registration fee is applied per child and is payable on Registration Day. GST is applied so that this is tax deductible.

KINDERGARTEN: \$35.00 (plus GST)

PRE-PRIMARY: \$60.00 (plus GST)

YEARS 1 – 7: \$70.00 (plus GST)

## 2012 SCHOOL LEVIES

The following levies will appear on your fee statements when they are posted out to you at the beginning of each term.

- Working Bee Levy – \$50.00 per family per term. This fee is refunded if your family is represented at a school working bee.
- Student Insurance - \$10.00 as an annual fee per child. This fee is usually charged to your account in Term 2.
- Swimming Lessons - \$25.00 per child per term. This fee does NOT apply for Kindergarten students.
- Fundraising Levy - \$20.00 per family per term.

## 2012 BUS FEE *if applicable* (includes GST)

- More than 10km - \$343.75 per term
- Less than 10km - \$310.00 per term

## BURSARY

Landsdale Gardens Adventist School offers support for those parents who are low income earners or who find themselves in financial hardship. Bursaries are given to those families who qualify for assistance. Parents seeking bursary must complete a confidential application form and submit it to the Principal. Bursary is given per term. Parents wishing to apply for bursary must complete and submit a Bursary Application Form in Terms 1 and 3.
