We are confident that our young women will embrace this exciting next chapter of their life journey as they continue to learn, pursuing their passions and interests, ultimately making a positive impact on the world.

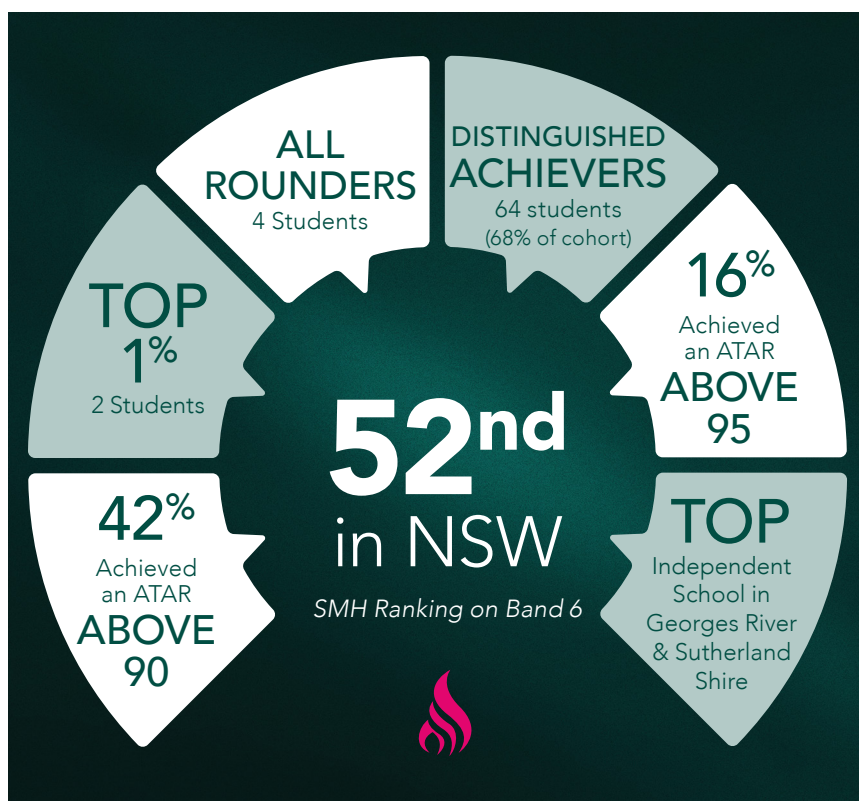
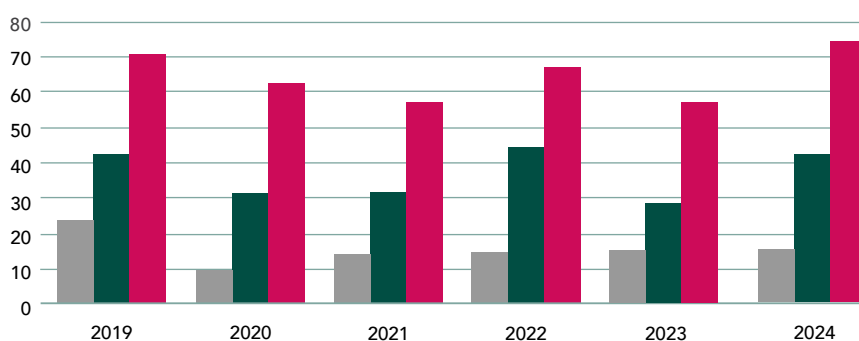

% Danebank ATAR Results Over 80, 90 and 95



Top 1%

2 Danebank students scored an ATAR above 99, placing them in the top 1% nationally.

- Abby Wong, 99.75
- Lara Lim, 99.70

Top % Nationally

- 15.9% of our Year 12 students achieved an ATAR above 95 (Top 5%).
- 42.5% of our Year 12 students achieved an ATAR above 90 (Top 10%).
- 75.5% of our Year 12 students scored an ATAR of 80 or above (Top 20%).

Significant Achievements

- 100% of Music 2 students received Band 6.
- 100% of Music Extension students received E4.
- Celeste Agnostino achieved a perfect score of 50 in Music Extension.
- Cara Lee was a finalist for the NSW Training Awards in the category of VET in Schools Student of the Year for the South West Sydney Region.
- Amelia Frost was awarded the VET Excellence Award for 2024 in Hospitality from the Youth Partnership.
- The Gold Duke of Edinburgh cohort for the class of 2024 was a small but extremely dedicated group - only the most determined of students persevered all the way to the gold award level. Of the 12 amazing young women who participated, 11 have already achieved their Gold Award.

Community Awareness

Our *Ut Prosim* and SRC communities raised more than \$22,200 for charities close to Danebank's heart, including the Katoke Trust, Got Ya Back Sista, Oz Harvest, Cancer Council, Butterfly Foundation. Also, as a school community Danebank completed 76 full hampers, over 130 boxes of extra food, over 20 large bags of toys for Anglicare's Toys'n'Tucker.

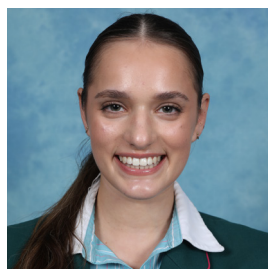

University Offers

The University of Sydney and UNSW will begin their offers to students. In addition to this, many of our students have already received early entry university offers* including:

- Macquarie University: 10 offers
- University of Wollongong: 35 offers
- University of Technology Sydney: 53 conditional offers
- University of Notre Dame: 12 offers
- UAC School Recommendation Scheme: 20 offers

The University of Sydney and UNSW offer early entry through their Gateway Scheme and Schools Recommendation Scheme as these places are only for students who meet their criteria for low socio-economic status.

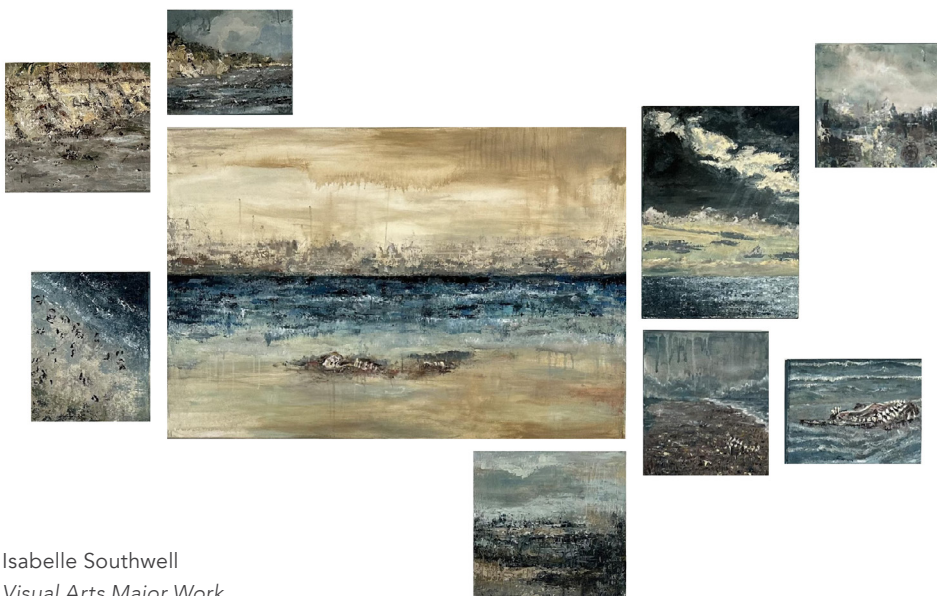
