Avila College was established in 1965 by the parishes of Mount Waverley, Glen Waverley, Syndal, Mulgrave and Jordanville who invited the Presentation Sisters to administer a Catholic College committed to the education of girls.

Central to this commitment is the belief that students learn when they are valued and respected. To that end, Avila's policies are based on Christian values which uphold the dignity of the human person.

The vision of Avila is to encourage each student to grow toward a womanhood of faith, hope and love.

Pastoral Care

Avila is well known for its care and the wellbeing of all students. We believe pastoral care is a crucial part of ensuring that our students have the best environment in which to grow spiritually, academically, socially and personally. We consciously focus on the development of positive and nurturing relationships within our community by providing many opportunities for students get to know themselves and each other, learn new skills, reflect on their rights and responsibilities, lead peers and contribute to the life of the College.

Pastoral care at Avila is a shared responsibility of all staff and includes initiatives such as a transition program from primary to secondary school; a homeroom teacher for each class; year level co-ordinators whose primary responsibility is pastoral care; a counselling team available to assist students, parents and staff; student leadership programs where students are encouraged to serve each other and the wider community; parent/teacher/student interviews.
