FOUR SCHOOLS IN ONE

Swan Valley Anglican Community School is organised into four distinct sub-schools:

- Early Childhood Learning Centre (K Year 2)
- Junior School (Year 3 Year 6)
- Middle School (Year 7 Year 9)
- Senior School (Year 10 Year 12)

This structure has been implemented in order that all children receive the specific academic and pastoral care that is appropriate to their individual phase of development. Associate Principals are in charge of each of the four sub-schools.

The K-12 campus also provides a wonderful opportunity for older students to work with and support younger students in their development. This aspect of peer support provides supportive role modelling to younger students whilst aiding the development of leadership, interpersonal and communication skills in our older students.
